Reporting to Regional Manager, Abingdon

Based at MoD site: ALC regional service delivery location

Main Purpose of Role:

The Fleet Support Engineer will provide ongoing assistance to all repair, maintenance and refurbishment projects across the entire range of the C Vehicle fleet.

Key Accountabilities:

- Repair, maintain and service, plant, equipment and associated ancillaries to current company standards and LOLER and PUWER legislation, both at regional pool location and on site as directed.
- Develop a strong working relationship with the Regional Manager and develop an interface with local MoD maintenance staff.
- Provide assistance to Project Managers to ensure that allocated projects adhere strictly with the project plan.
- Review the collation and input management of information arising from the task being carried out.
- Provide technical assistance to the Regional management teams as the subject matter expert for the work completed.
- Ensure that safe systems of work are adopted and company Health, Safety and Environmental policies are read, understood and adhered to at all times.
- Ensure that when working remotely effective time management systems are adopted to maximise output.
- Will be required to work at any ALC location which could involve long periods of time away from home.

Qualifications, Knowledge & Skills:

- Working knowledge of Health & Safety, LOLER and PUWER regulations.
- Articulate, professional and good communication skills.
- Experience in construction related plant maintenance.
- City and Guilds, NVQ or equivalent in mechanical engineering.
- Computer literacy.

Essential:

- No restrictions to gaining MoD security clearance.
- Full UK driving licence.
- HGV licence.
- Able to demonstrate a positive culture for their own and others' safety, to be able to complete work based dynamic risk assessments and to assist in the production of hazard surveys and safe systems of work.
- Physically fit to assist in loading and unloading of equipment, tools, STTE and spares.
- Valid passport as potential for occasional travel to overseas locations.
- Able to maintain periods of intense workload.
